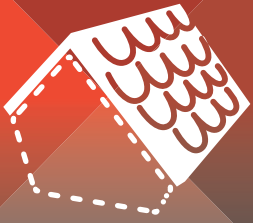




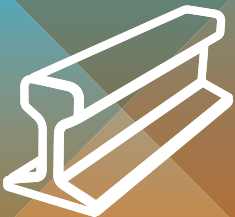

## THE INDUSTRIAL EMISSIONS DIRECTIVE REQUIRES THE EU'S 50 000 LARGEST INDUSTRIAL INSTALLATIONS TO USE BEST AVAILABLE TECHNIQUES (BAT)

- Best means most effective in achieving a high general level of protection of the environment as a whole;
- Available means developed on a scale to be implemented in the sector under economically and technically viable conditions, taking into consideration advantages and cost;
- Techniques means the technology used as well as the way the installation is designed, built, maintained, operated and decommissioned.
