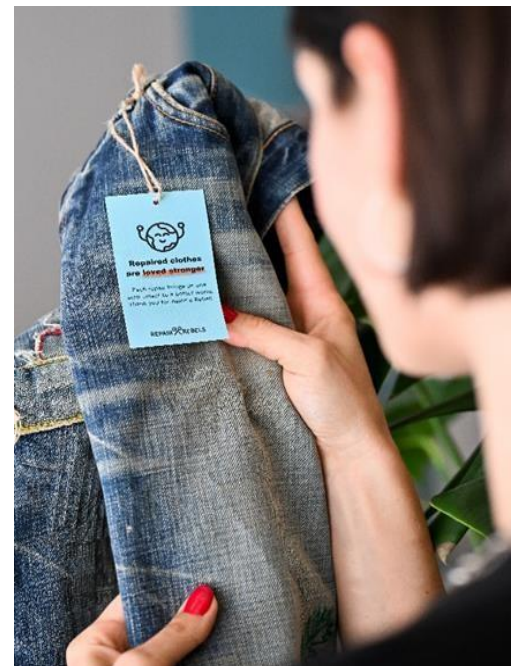
Repair Rebels is Germany's pioneering platform for modern, digital fashion repair and alteration services.
